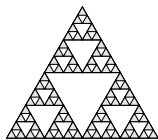

10 ducks are swimming in a pond.

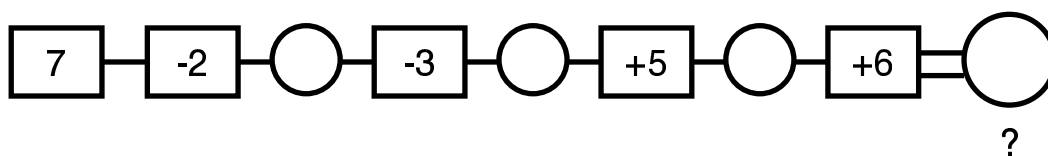
6 ducks get out.

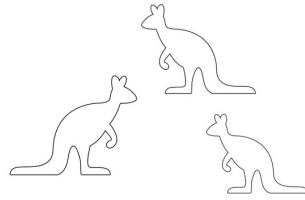

Three kangaroos are named Joey, Jumpy and Jack.

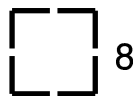
All three kangaroos are different sizes.
